

HISTORIC POSTCARD COLLECTION IS NOW ONLINE

Some of the most interesting images in the archives are found in our historic postcard collection. These images can now be viewed digitally on the website: [Postcard Collection](#). Over 100 postcard images are available, covering a wide range of subjects, places, and structures. While most of the images are set in Washington County, Johnson City, and Jonesborough, there are several other localities included, such as places in Carter, Greene, and Sullivan counties.

The collection includes images of churches, historic sites and houses, public buildings, banks and other businesses, street scenes, campus scenes at East Tennessee State University, as well as the Veterans Administration campus at Mountain Home, and more. Though most of the cards are undated, almost all are of the 20th Century.
