**Item 1:** Unframed 8 X 10 copy of a photo of General A. E. Jackson (in uniform) taken many years after the Civil War, as it is obvious he is an older man. This photo was given to Allyson Wilkinson at a County Commissioners' Meeting by John Lyle who had several copies that he gave to anyone who wanted one.

**Items 3 and 4: Provenance:** The framed photographs of Montraville Jones and his wife, Isabella Young Jones were donated to the Washington County Archive by Jim Hartsell, 506 Montelluna Drive, North Venice, Florida, 34275, on February 6, 2018. Mr. Hartsell inherited the two framed photographs which have been passed down through the family.

**Biographical/Historical Note:** Montraville Jones was born 1832 in Sullivan County, Tennessee. On May 22, 1856, he married Isabella Young, in Washington County, Tennessee. Isabella was the daughter of Hugh and Hester Young. Montraville served in the Union Army, 8<sup>th</sup> TN Cavalry during the Civil War.
