

DEED BOOK A, AN INDEX

One of the most important books to Washington County is the first deed book—Deed Book A, sometimes known as the “Watauga Purchase.” This volume contains the earliest deeds and land grants for what became Washington County and the surrounding area, beginning with an indenture between the settlers of the area and the local Cherokee chiefs, dated 1775. The volume was used to record deeds, land grants, patents and indentures of the early settlers of what is now known as northeast Tennessee.

Spelling and punctuation have not been corrected, except where necessary for clarity and notes are entered as they appear in the original record.
