Provenance: The collection was donated on April 15, 2014 by Carol Redmond, Bristol, Tenn., project chairman, on behalf of the society.

Access Note: The collection is available for research use.

Historical Note: In 2013, the State of Franklin Chapter of the National Daughters of the American Revolution (D.A.R.) received a grant from the Tennessee Historical Commission to conduct a survey of historic homes located inside the city limits of Jonesborough, Tenn., but outside the current historic district. Jonesborough, the state's oldest town, has many of the state's oldest houses.

Scope and Content Note: The collection consists of documentation of a survey of historic homes in Jonesborough, Tennessee. It includes two DVD discs containing digital files of the survey and a program distributed at the 2014 Oak Leaf Awards presentation held at the Jonesborough Visitors Center on January 17, 2014, where volunteers who had worked on the project for the State of Franklin D.A.R. chapter were honored.
