Historical Note

The Office of Emergency Management, formally known as the Office of Civil Defense, was created in 1941 during World War II. The office started at the national level and soon reached the community level with volunteers serving as members. Currently, the department is known as the Washington County-Johnson City Emergency Management Agency. The agency assists county residents in preparing for and handling emergency situations. Directors have included James Lundy, Nes Levotch, and currently Rusty Sells, among others.

Scope and Content

Records cover the period 1960-2013 and include administrative material related to department's budget and funding. Records, such as maps and reports, detail the county's community shelter plans, fallout shelter locations, and instructions to follow in the event of a nuclear attack. In addition, this collection contains newspapers and clippings with coverage of the department's involvement in the county, particularly during disasters such as floods and tornados. Publications include manuals and handbooks from the Office of Civil Defense and the United States Army.
